I have in my hand, from the congressional record Thursday, Jan. 10, 1963, a document titled Current Communist Goals.

The entry is identified as an excerpt from "The Naked Communist," by Cleon Skousen.

This lists 45 goals of the Communist Party to be put into place, presumably to overtake America. It makes for fascinating reading.

Goal No. 3 - develop the illusion that total disarmament of United States would be a demonstration moral strength. Interesting that the communist should recognize that this position would be an illusion. This illusion is now accepted as fact thirty-seven years later.

Oh, here's a good one, No. 4 - permit free-trade between all nations regardless of communist affiliation and regardless of whether or not items could be used for war. Free trade is a pro communist position. Hmmm. . . .

No. 11 - promote the U.N. has the only hope for mankind. There is a notation attached, "Some communist leaders believe the world can be taken over as easily by the U.N. has by Moscow." Oh, really? Isn't this what those so-called Patriot groups have been harping about? Aren't they being called kooks because of it? Curious.

No. 12 - resist any attempt to outlaw the Communist Party. Res ipsa loquitur.
