<b>NOTICE OF DESIGNATION OF ANOTHER METHOD OF RECORDING          TESTIMONY UNDER C.R.C.P. 30(3)</b>	

Comes now Respondent, Suzanne Shell, in response to Complainant's Notice to Take Deposition and Subpoena, and states as follows:

Respondent hereby gives notice that, in addition to the heretofore unspecified method by which the subject deposition will be recorded (C.R.C.P. 30(2)), Respondent will be designating, and providing at her own expense, another method of recording the testimony; specifically sound-and-visual.

To insure that there is adequate space for the equipment and personnel, Respondent notifies the Petitioner that this method of recording will require an audio/visual crew of not less than two persons.

Since the Respondent is bearing the expense of this recording, and to eliminate undue hardship or harassment, she would respectfully request 48 hours notice of change of date, time, or location to insure her limited resources are not wasted with appearances that have been cancelled or postponed.
